



10 Days of Petition

Petition simply means to ask. During these next ten days of Prayer and Fasting, we will ask God for everything that comes to mind. This is all about taking all our concerns to God as He has commanded us.

DAY 1 – Make a List of Petitions

Philippians 4:4–7

⁴ Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice! ⁵ Let your gentleness be evident to all. The Lord is near. ⁶ Do not be anxious about anything, **but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God.** ⁷ And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. (NIV)

Day 2 – Ask, Seek and Knock

Matthew 7:7–14

7:7–11pp—Lk 11:9–13

⁷ “Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. ⁸ For everyone who asks receives; the one who seeks finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened. (NIV)

Day 3 – Pray for the Kingdom (God’s Way of Life)

Matthew 6:9–13

⁹ “This, then, is how you should pray:

“ ‘Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, ¹⁰ your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. (NIV)

Day 4 - Stick to the Basics – What are your daily needs?

Matthew 6:11

¹¹ Give us today our daily bread. (NIV)

Day 5 – Pray for Forgiveness of Sins

Matthew 6:12

¹² And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. (NIV)

Day 6 – Pray for Strength to Defeat the Enemy

Matthew 6:13

¹³ And lead us not into temptation but deliver us from the evil one.’ (NIV)

Day 7 – Pray for Our Leaders

1 Timothy 2:1–2

I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for all people—² **for kings and all those in authority**, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness. (NIV)

Day 8 – Pray for the Salvation of Souls

John 17:24 (NIV)

²⁴ “Father, I want those you have given me to be with me where I am, and to see my glory, the glory you have given me because you loved me before the creation of the world.

Day 9 – Pray for Opportunity to be Used by God

1 Peter 4:10–11

¹⁰ Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God’s grace in its various forms. ¹¹ If anyone speaks, they should do so as one who speaks the very words of God. If anyone serves, they should do so with the strength God provides, so that in all things God may be praised through Jesus Christ. To him be the glory and the power for ever and ever. Amen. (NIV)

Day 10 – Let the Holy Spirit Pray Through You

Romans 8:26–27

²⁶ In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us through wordless groans. ²⁷ And he who searches our hearts knows the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for God’s people in accordance with the will of God. (NIV)
