



10 DAYS OF PROCLAMATION

For ten days, let's focus our hearts and prayers on the mission of God. Proclamation of the Gospel is the simple task of sharing the Good News. Jesus died for our sins, rose from the dead to eternal life and now invites us to join Him through faith. Let's pray that God prepares us for the mission to which He has called us. **LET'S PRAY TO PROCLAIM!!**

DAY 1 – PRAY FOR THE GREAT COMMISSION

Matthew 28:19–20 (NIV)

¹⁹ **Therefore go and make disciples of all nations**, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.”

DAY 2 – PRAY FOR THE POWER TO SHARE OUR STORY

Acts 1:8 (NIV)

⁸ But **you will receive power** when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and **you will be my witnesses** in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.”

DAY 3 – PRAY FOR JESUS TO CLARIFY YOUR STORY

1 John 1:1–4 (NIV)

That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked at and our hands have touched—this we proclaim concerning the Word of life. ² The life appeared; **we have seen it and testify to it**, and **we proclaim to you the eternal life, which was with the Father and has appeared to us**. ³ **We proclaim to you what we have seen and heard, so that you also may have fellowship with us**. And our fellowship is with the Father and with his Son, Jesus Christ. ⁴ We write this to make our joy complete.

DAY 4 – PRAY FOR OPEN DOORS

Colossians 4:2–5 (NIV)

² Devote yourselves to prayer, being watchful and thankful. ³ **And pray for us, too, that God may open a door for our message**, so that we may proclaim the mystery of Christ, for which I am in chains. ⁴ Pray that I may proclaim it clearly, as I should. ⁵ Be wise in the way you act toward outsiders; make the most of every opportunity.

DAY 5 – PRAY TO PREACH EVERYWHERE AND ANYWHERE

Acts 8:4–5 (NIV)

⁴Those who had been scattered **preached the word wherever** they went. ⁵Philip went down to a city in Samaria and proclaimed the Messiah there.

DAY 6 – ARE YOU CALLED TO PROCLAIM?

Romans 15:16 (NIV)

He gave me the **priestly duty of proclaiming the gospel** of God, so that the Gentiles might become an offering acceptable to God, sanctified by the Holy Spirit.

DAY 7 – PRAY FOR GOD’S STRENGTH AND PROTECTION TO PROCLAIM

2 Timothy 4:17 (NIV)

¹⁷But **the Lord stood at my side and gave me strength**, so that through me the message might be fully proclaimed and all the Gentiles might hear it. And I was delivered from the lion’s mouth.

DAY 8 – PRAY FOR A PLACE TO PROCLAIM

Luke 9:1–6 (NIV)

When Jesus had called the Twelve together, he gave them power and authority to drive out all demons and to cure diseases, ² and **he sent them out to proclaim the kingdom of God** and to heal the sick. ³ He told them: “Take nothing for the journey—no staff, no bag, no bread, no money, no extra shirt. ⁴ Whatever house you enter, stay there until you leave that town. ⁵ If people do not welcome you, leave their town and shake the dust off your feet as a testimony against them.” ⁶ So they set out and went from village to village, proclaiming the good news and healing people everywhere.

DAY 9 – PRAY THAT FEAR IS REMOVED

Philippians 1:14 (NIV)

¹⁴And because of my chains, most of the brothers and sisters have become confident in the Lord and dare all the more to **proclaim the gospel without fear**.

DAY 10 – PRAY THAT WE MODEL CHRIST AND HIS MISSION

Luke 4:16–21 (NIV)

¹⁶He went to Nazareth, where he had been brought up, and on the Sabbath day he went into the synagogue, as was his custom. He stood up to read, ¹⁷ and the scroll of the prophet Isaiah was handed to him. Unrolling it, he found the place where it is written:

¹⁸“The Spirit of the Lord is on me, because he has anointed me to **proclaim good news to the poor**. He has sent me to **proclaim freedom for the prisoners** and **recovery of sight for the blind**, to **set the oppressed free**, ¹⁹ to **proclaim the year of the Lord’s favor**.”
